1. Enjoy Lloret Beach



One of the main reasons why you choose Lloret de Mar as a holiday destination is probably the sun and the fine beaches. Is that right? The beach of Lloret de Mar can therefore not be missed on this list with 13 must-do tips.

Lloret beach is the largest beach in the city and is very centrally located and therefore easily accessible. You can rent umbrellas, sunbeds and even hammocks here. You will also find many water activities here and plenty of restaurants and cafes to choose from. Lloret beach may be a bit busy, but the nice thing about this is that there is always something to do.

2. Discover the Fenals beach



Fenals Beach is located on Lloret Beach but is separated by a piece of land with pine trees. This is the third largest beach in Lloret de Mar. Fenals beach is 700 meters long and considerably narrower than Lloret beach, however Fenals beach is a very nice option because it radiates a less touristy atmosphere.

You will find both catering establishments and more natural areas on this beach, depending on the stretch of beach you are on. Fenals Beach is the ideal option for families and couples who prefer a little more privacy.

3. Find the peace on the Santa Cristina beach



Do you prefer small beaches with a lot of nature? Then the Santa Cristina beach is a good option. This beach is a bit further away, so you can enjoy more peace and nature here. You will not be bothered by traffic or city noise here. Despite the fact that the beach is a bit more remote, this

certainly does not mean that there are few services here. You'll also find showers, lockers, umbrella rentals and kiosks that sell drinks and ice cream.

4. Visit Castell d'en Plaja



Located at the end of Lloret beach, this castle was built between 1930 and 1940 by the local industrialist Narcís Plaja. The castle is therefore not that old at all, although it certainly seems so. This is because of Plaja's preference for a medieval design, which makes it look like the building comes from a medieval fairy tale.

You can also visit the castle and the steep stairs will lead you to a viewpoint with a beautiful panoramic view over Lloret de Mar. The best time to come here is in the evening because you can enjoy a beautiful sunset!

5. Visit Sant Romà kerk



Anyone who has visited Lloret de Mar will certainly know the Sant Romà church. This is a notable landmark in the center of the city. This church has the typical Catalan Gothic style. The church is also worth a visit, because the church has a special, colorful decoration.

6. Go back in time with a visit to the Puig de Castellet Iberian ruins

Puig de Castellet is an old settlement of the first inhabitants of Lloret de Mar. This is therefore a great place to delve into the history of this area. Take a tour and discover the culture and customs of these first inhabitants. These ruins are about 2300 years old and in addition to these special historical features, they also have a beautiful panoramic view of Lloret and Blanes.

7. Discover Santa Clotilde gardens



The Santa Clotilde Gardens are located next to Fenals Beach and have a special location on a cliff. The gardens are almost 100 years old and have an Italian Renaissance style. This of course means that they are beautiful romantic gardens with special fountains and marble sculptures.

You will also find the most exotic trees and flowers here. And if that wasn't romantic enough, you also have a fantastic view over the sea. So you will find a special combination of nature and a breathtaking view over the sea here. To enjoy! Don't forget to bring your camera, you will want to take many pictures here.

8. Do a beautiful hiking
